

LABORATORY ROTATION IN MEDICINAL CHEMISTRY (16:663:508)

Laboratory Rotation in Medicinal Chemistry is a 3 credit elective course designed to expose the student to the research environments in TWO or THREE different laboratories. It is intended for students that have NOT YET decided on a research advisor. A letter grade will be assigned at the end of the semester. **If you stay in only one laboratory for the entire semester THIS DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A ROTATION and your registration will be changed to Research in Medicinal Chemistry.** If you have already decided on an advisor you should register for Research in Medicinal Chemistry. Possible grades for Research in Medicinal Chemistry are S/U and do not affect your GPA and does not count as an elective course. You may arrange for two 7-week rotations or three 5-week rotations.
